

Goal 4: Respect the character of Midcoast communities and protect coastal resources.





Recommended Projects



Walk

- A multimodal trail parallel to Highway 1
- Safe crosswalks across Highway 1
- Add sidewalks, where missing
- Complete Coastal Trail





Bike

- Multimodal trail
- Bike lanes along Highway 1
- Bikeway along Airport Street
- Widen the shoulders of Capistrano Road for bike route
- Install bicycle parking



Drive

- Add turn lanes, acceleration lanes and passing lanes
- Add stop signs, where missing
- Add roundabout or signals at intersections with heavy traffic
- Traffic calming projects
- Parking improvements
- Highway 1 shoulder improvements


